<b>BRIEF OVERVIEW:</b>	Pleasant, cooperative 79 year old male with osteoarthritis, and atrial fibrillation. Lives with daughter in single story home, 2 step entry. Daughter fills pill box and provides medication reminders daily. Member is Incontinent of urine. Wears depends on average 4x/day with underpad at night. Requires assistance with all IADLs. Also requires assistance bathing, dressing and toileting. Member uses walker in the home and transport wheelchair for travel. Daughter does not drive but does accompany member to all medical appointments. Home is spacious and clutter free. No trip hazards noted. Last ER visit was 9 months ago in 3/2013 due to fever, change in mental status. Member was admitted with diagnosis of pneumonia. 2 week SNF stay status post 3 day hospitalization.
<b>CURRENT SERVICES:</b>	PCA 10 hours week; ADH 3 day/s per week MWF
<b>CURRENT DME:</b>	Walker, wheelchair, Shower chair, 2 grab bars in shower, one grab bar by toilet, raised toilet seat, bed rail.
<b>CURRENT SUPPLIES:</b>	Pull-ups 4x/day and disposable underpad every night
<b>TREATING PROVIDERS:</b>	Dr. Hajjaj PCP, q 3 months, next visit 1/10/2014; Dr. Jones, Cardiology 6 months, next visit 2/13/2014; Dr. James, Rheumatologist, q 6 months, next visit 3/8/2014.
<b>PLAN/AREAS OF CONCERN/NEXT STEPS:</b>	Daughter requests increased PCA hours. Currently receives 10 hrs PCA per week. Functional summary indicates 14 hours per week appropriate per week - daytime hours. Order Incontinence Supplies
<b>ALLERGIES:</b>	Member reports they are allergic to penicillin.
<b>ADVANCED DIRECTIVES:</b>	Member reports they have advanced directives on file with PCP.
