

## Tuesday Tip – Medications/Medical History Tab

The expectation is that Care Managers are to do a **thorough medication review** during in-home assessments. It's true that the Medications/Medical History tab is for "self reported" medications, but opportunities can be missed by not reviewing a member's medication bottles in the home.

When entering medications for members on the Medication/Medical History Tab, Care Managers should make sure they include the strength and formulation (tablet or capsule) along with the medication name in the **Medication Name** field. The **Dosage** field should be used to document how much of the medication the member is to take.

### Examples:


Name: Metformin 500mg Tablet (how the prescription bottle reads)

Dose: 1000mg bid

Name: Metformin 500mg Tablet

Dose: 500mg bid
