



Here is today's tip devised by the Tufts Health Plan SCO Care Management team. Please let me know if you have any questions.

Tufts Health Plan SCO is required to report on information regarding member deaths. To this end, the **Place of Death** and **Cause of Death** must be populated in CaseTrakker on the Member File screen when a death takes place. Simply select the most appropriate descriptor from the dropdown menus.

When reviewing a member record, the following may be indicators as to whether that member has passed away:

- **Eligible Status** = Terminated
- **Date of Death** is populated
- **SCO Disenrollment Reason** = Death

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
