

Buprenorphine Training Reimbursement Form

Tufts Health Plan's Behavioral Health Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Quality Improvement Strategy (QIS) Program:

Tufts Health Plan will reimburse up to \$300 to the first 100 eligible providers who become certified to prescribe buprenorphine.

In order for a provider to receive reimbursement offered as part of the SUD QIS Program, providers must:

- Be credentialed MD, doctor of osteopathy, nurse practitioner or physician assistant, and be contracted with Tufts Health Plan on the date of training
- Complete training within the 2020 calendar year
- Complete and submit this form along with all required documentation (as noted below) during the 2020 calendar year
- Be one of the first 100 providers to complete the training and submit this form to Tufts Health Plan
- Respond within five business days, should Tufts Health Plan contact you requesting clarification

Note: Providers may not seek reimbursement for costs associated with maintaining an existing waiver or a request to increase patient limits.
