Overview

Tufts Health Plan SCO is a benefit plan offered through a contract between Tufts Health Plan and the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS).

Tufts Health Plan SCO provides MassHealth Standard (Medicaid) and Medicare coverage plus additional benefits. There is no member cost-share for covered services received from providers participating in the Tufts Health Plan SCO network. All members are also required to choose a PCP participating in the network.

Eligibility

Members are eligible to join Tufts Health Plan SCO if they meet MassHealth Standard (Medicaid) eligibility requirements. To join Tufts Health Plan SCO (HMO-SNP), members must be:

- Eligible for Medicare Part A
- Enrolled in Medicare Part B and MassHealth Standard (Medicaid)
- Live in the following Massachusetts counties: Barnstable, Bristol, Essex, Hampden, Hampshire, Middlesex, Norfolk, Plymouth, Suffolk or Worcester
