Overview

Tufts Health Plan Spirit is an EPO plan. It offers the same benefits as the GIC Navigator plan with the following exceptions:

- The Spirit provider network has fewer participating providers and hospitals than the Navigator network (i.e., the provider access service area is limited).
- The Spirit plan has no out-of-network (unauthorized) benefits, except for emergency and urgent care.

Service Area

Tufts Health Plan Spirit members must live in one of the following counties: Barnstable, Bristol, Essex, Franklin, Hampden, Middlesex, Norfolk, Plymouth, Suffolk, or Worcester, or in certain towns in Berkshire and Hampshire counties. Tufts Health Plan Spirit is not available in Dukes and Nantucket counties.

Tiering

Spirit is a two-tiered plan. Member cost share varies by tier. PCPs and PCP/Specialists are not tiered. Tier designs are updated each plan year. To verify your tier or a provider to whom you are referring a member, refer to the <u>Provider Directory</u> or use the <u>Find a Doctor</u> search.

<u>Pharmacy</u>

Members have annual individual and family deductibles for prescription drugs. Prescription drug copayments only apply after members meet the pharmacy deductible.
